

REBATES REQUIRING APPLICATION



Clothes Washer Save \$100

All Albertans who purchase and install an ENERGY STAR® qualified clothes washer on or after January 1, 2009 are eligible for a \$100 rebate. The clothes washer must be purchased and installed for non-commercial use in Alberta. We require a copy of the receipt indicating the payment method (in full) along with the manufacturer and model of the clothes washer you purchased. If the new washer is a replacement purchase, the original must be taken out of service and properly recycled where facilities exist.



New Home Save up to \$10,000

All Albertans who take possession of a new EnerGuide labelled single-family or multi-family row home (excluding stacked multi-family construction) on or after January 1, 2009 are eligible for one of the following rebates:

- \$1,500 for new homes that meet or exceed EnerGuide 80;
- \$3,000 for new homes that meet or exceed EnerGuide 82; or
- \$10,000 for new homes that meet or exceed EnerGuide 86.

To be eligible for the rebate, the new home must be purchased and occupied for non-commercial use in Alberta. You will also need to have received your EnerGuide file number prior to submitting your application.

RETROFIT REBATES - NO APPLICATION REQUIRED

When you participate in the federal ecoENERGY Retrofit Program, you can receive complementary provincial rebates for upgrades to **domestic hot water** and **insulation**. As part of the federal program, a pre-retrofit evaluation is performed by a Natural Resources Canada-certified energy advisor. Once you have completed the recommended upgrades, the energy advisor returns for a post-retrofit evaluation to validate your improvements. The provincial government is also providing a rebate to help offset the cost of the **home energy evaluation**. Aligning the province's rebates to this federal program ensures third-party, certified verification. This keeps our administration costs down by using the federal approval process and helps Albertans access additional grants from the federal government.

No application is necessary! We automatically receive the information we require from Natural Resources Canada to issue a cheque for the insulation, domestic hot water and home energy evaluation rebates.

Home Energy Evaluation Save up to \$200

All Albertans who participate in the federal government's ecoENERGY Retrofit Program are eligible for a provincial rebate:

- A \$100 rebate is provided to all homeowners who complete a pre-retrofit evaluation by a Natural Resources Canada-certified energy advisor on or after January 1, 2009.
- An additional \$100 rebate is provided to all homeowners who complete a post-retrofit evaluation by a Natural Resources Canada-certified energy advisor on or after January 1, 2009.



Insulation Save up to \$3,150

All Albertans who participate in the federal government's ecoENERGY Retrofit Program, perform qualifying insulation upgrades, and undertake a post-retrofit evaluation on or after January 1, 2009 are eligible for a provincial rebate.

Up to a \$3,150 rebate is provided to all homeowners who perform qualifying insulation upgrades as identified in their home energy evaluation report. The provincial rebate provides an additional 75% of the federal grant for ceiling insulation, exterior wall insulation, exposed floor insulation, basement header insulation and foundation insulation (inclusive of basement insulation and crawl space insulation).



Domestic Hot Water Save up to \$300

All Albertans who participate in the federal government's ecoENERGY Retrofit Program, replace their domestic hot water system with a qualifying model, and undertake a post-retrofit evaluation on or after January 1, 2009 are eligible for one of the following rebates:

- \$250 for an ENERGY STAR® qualified instantaneous (tankless), gas-fired water heater with an energy factor (EF) of 0.82 or higher and meets the specifications of the ecoENERGY Retrofit Program;
- \$300 for an ENERGY STAR qualified instantaneous (tankless), condensing gas-fired water heater with an EF of 0.90 or higher and meets the specifications of the ecoENERGY Retrofit Program; or
- \$300 for a condensing gas-storage water heater with a thermal efficiency of 94% or higher and meets the specifications of the ecoENERGY Retrofit Program.

REBATES REQUIRING APPLICATION

The provincial government is offering rebates for **clothes washers, furnaces/boilers, and new homes**. Applications are required. Go to www.ClimateChangeCentral.com, select **my rebates** and click the appropriate icon. You'll find an Apply Now button which allows you to apply online (faster processing) or print a paper application. You can also phone our call centre at **1-888-537-7202** and have an application sent to you. Full application requirements are available online or through the call centre.



Furnace/Boiler Save up to \$600

All Albertans who purchase and install a qualifying replacement furnace or boiler on or after January 1, 2009 are eligible for one of the following rebates:

- \$400 for an ENERGY STAR® qualified furnace with an annual fuel utilization efficiency (AFUE) of 92% or better;
- \$500 for an ENERGY STAR qualified furnace with an AFUE of 92% or better and a DC variable-speed motor;
- \$600 for an ENERGY STAR qualified oil boiler with an AFUE of 85% or better;
- \$600 for an ENERGY STAR qualified condensing gas boiler with an AFUE of 90% or better; or
- in the case of mobile homes only, where a zero-clearance furnace is being replaced, \$400 for an ENERGY STAR qualified gas furnace with an AFUE of 90% or better.

While participation in the federal ecoENERGY Retrofit Program is not required to receive the provincial furnace/boiler rebate, if you are planning other energy efficiency upgrades you are advised to begin with a home energy evaluation. This will allow you to access additional federal grant money and, depending on the upgrades, other rebates.
