



What is the furnace/boiler rebate?

Climate Change Central and the Government of Alberta are working towards improving energy efficiency in Alberta. The provincial government is providing a \$400-\$600 rebate to all eligible Albertans who **replace** their current furnace or boiler with a qualifying model:

- \$400 for an ENERGY STAR® qualified furnace with an annual fuel utilization efficiency (AFUE) of 92% or better;
- \$500 for an ENERGY STAR® qualified furnace with an AFUE of 92% or better and a DC variable-speed motor;
- \$600 for an ENERGY STAR® qualified oil boiler with an AFUE of 85% or better;
- \$600 for an ENERGY STAR® qualified condensing gas boiler with an AFUE of 90% or better; or
- in the case of mobile homes only, where a zero-clearance furnace is being replaced, \$400 for an ENERGY STAR® qualified gas furnace with an AFUE of 90% or better.

Some municipalities may contribute rebate dollars for this action. This will be automatically calculated when you enter your postal code, whether you apply online or with a paper application. I have purchased an ENERGY STAR® furnace/boiler that is not in the drop-down list of eligible models but believe it meets the eligibility criteria. Whom should I contact?

Our list of eligible models is based upon information we receive from Natural Resources Canada (NRCAN). Once we have received your information, we will confirm the model eligibility with NRCAN directly and provide you with a response.

Can I apply for more than one furnace/boiler rebate?

Yes, for each qualifying replacement furnace/boiler you purchase and install in Alberta, you are eligible for a rebate. A separate application is required for each furnace or boiler.

Does this apply to new houses?

No. Units installed in newly constructed homes are NOT eligible for this rebate.

Can I combine this rebate with the federal government's ecoENERGY Retrofit Program?

Yes. You are not required to participate in the federal ecoENERGY Retrofit Program in order to apply for the provincial rebate. However, if you are planning any efficiency upgrades to your home, you are well-advised to begin with a Natural Resources Canada-certified home energy evaluation. Improving your home based on your personalized report will allow you to qualify for federal grants, including one for furnaces. You will not qualify for a federal grant if you make changes to your home prior to undergoing a pre-retrofit evaluation (the federal government does provide an emergency exception to this rule during the heating season; for more information on the federal Emergency Heating System Replacement policy, click [here](#)).

When can I expect to see my money?

Online applications require at least eight weeks to process and deliver your rebate cheque if approved. Be advised, paper applications take two to three weeks longer to process. If you have access to the internet, we encourage you to use our online application as you will be able to set up an account and track the progress of your application from start to finish.
