



Low-Flush/Dual-Flush Toilet Rebate Application Requirements

my rebates

Eligibility

To be eligible for the rebate you must meet the following requirements:

- ✓ Residents of the municipalities listed below must ORDER and PURCHASE in full a WaterSense labelled low-flush or dual-flush toilet on or after the following dates:

Funded by	Effective Purchase Date
 Leduc residents only	January 1, 2009
 Red Deer County residents only	January 1, 2010
 The City of SPRUCE GROVE	January 1, 2010
 Strathcona County UTILITIES	January 1, 2012
 TOWN OF STONY PLAIN	February 1, 2011
 Lac La Biche County welcoming by nature.	January 1, 2011

- ✓ The low-flush/dual-flush toilet must be WaterSense labelled;
- ✓ The low-flush/dual-flush toilet MUST be a replacement unit. Units installed in newly constructed homes or add-on bathrooms are NOT eligible;
- ✓ Residents of Red Deer County and Strathcona County are limited to one toilet rebate per household. Residents of Lac La Biche County are limited to two toilet rebates per household. Residents of the City of Leduc, the City of Spruce Grove and the Town of Stony Plain may apply for an unlimited number of toilet rebates.
- ✓ The low-flush/dual-flush toilet MUST be purchased AND installed for non-commercial use in the municipality where the rebate is being offered; and
- ✓ The existing toilet MUST be taken out of service and properly recycled where facilities exist.

Information

In order to process your application, we require the following information:

- ✓ Manufacturer and model number of the new low-flush/dual-flush toilet;
- ✓ Purchase date of the new low-flush/dual-flush toilet;
- ✓ Installation address;
- ✓ Manufacturer of the old toilet;
- ✓ Model number of the old toilet (if known);
- ✓ Approximate age of the old toilet; and
- ✓ Applicant's name, address, phone number and email address. For residents of Red Deer County, the roll # from your County tax notice will also be required.

Documentation

In order to process your application, we require a copy of the purchase receipt. The following information MUST be clearly indicated on the purchase receipt:

- ✓ Payment method and proof of total amount paid in full (an invoice or till receipt showing amount due will not be accepted);
- ✓ Applicant's name or identifier (Applicant MUST be the purchaser);
- ✓ Purchase date;
- ✓ Manufacturer and model (or store identifier) of the low-flush/dual-flush toilet; and
- ✓ Business address from which the low-flush/dual-flush toilet was purchased.
