



Eligibility

To be eligible for the rebate you must meet the following requirements:

- ✓ You must take possession of a new EnerGuide 80+ labelled single-family or multi-family row home (excluding stacked multi-family construction) on or after January 1, 2009;
- ✓ The new home must be labelled with an EnerGuide rating of 80 or above as per the specifications outlined by Natural Resources Canada and the Office of Energy Efficiency. Please be advised that the EnerGuide Rating must be completed within 6 months of your home's completion. For more information on the EnerGuide Rating Service, please click [here](#).
- ✓ The Certified Energy Advisor determining the EnerGuide rating must use version 10 of the HOT2000 evaluation software, effective August 1, 2009;
- ✓ You must receive your EnerGuide label and report in the mail from your builder or NRCan licensed service organization with your EnerGuide file number; and
- ✓ The new home MUST be occupied for non-commercial use in Alberta (as indicated on the purchase contract or Final Occupancy Report).

Information

In order to process your application, we require the following information:

- ✓ EnerGuide file number;
- ✓ EnerGuide rating;
- ✓ Date of possession/occupancy; and
- ✓ Applicant's name, address, phone number and email address.

Documentation

In order to process your application, we require a copy of the purchase contract. The following information MUST be clearly indicated on the purchase contract:

- ✓ Applicant's name (Applicant MUST be the purchaser);
- ✓ Seller's name (Seller MUST be the builder);
- ✓ Home address in Alberta;
- ✓ Date of possession; and
- ✓ Total amount paid in full.

In the case that the owner is also the builder, a Final Occupancy Report must be provided. The following information MUST be clearly indicated:

- ✓ Applicant's name (Applicant must be the owner);
- ✓ Home address in Alberta; and
- ✓ Date of occupancy.
