



What is the new home rebate?

Climate Change Central and the Government of Alberta are working towards improving energy efficiency in Alberta. The provincial government is providing a \$1,500 - \$10,000 rebate to all eligible Albertans who take possession of a new EnerGuide labelled single-family or multi-family row home (excluding stacked multi-family construction) that meets the following efficiency standards:

- \$1,500 for new homes that meet or exceed EnerGuide 80;
- \$3,000 for new homes that meet or exceed EnerGuide 82; or
- \$10,000 for new homes that meet or exceed EnerGuide 86.

How do I know if I'm eligible?

How do I apply for the rebate?

You must receive your EnerGuide file number from your builder or Natural Resources Canada (NRCAN) licensed service organization before you are able to apply. Please refer to the [How to Apply](#) document for a full description of the application process.

When can I expect to see my money?

Allow at least eight weeks to process your application and deliver your rebate cheque upon approval. Online applications are processed the quickest resulting in a shorter wait time for your rebate cheque to arrive in the mail. If you apply online and choose to set up an account with Climate Change Central, you will be able to track the progress of your application from start to finish.
